PCO Meeting: Transitions – Thursday, November 9, 7:00-8:30 PM in the Upper School Cafe



PCO Structure

First and foremost, the Parent Community Organization is made up of parents and guardians of current ECS students, as as well as school employees and Board of Trustees members. The PCO Steering Committee coordinates the overall activities of the PCO, but much of the PCO's work is done by committees and individual volunteers. Grade Level Representatives are parent representatives who meet with the principals each month to discuss parent concerns and questions. Room parents coordinate classroom activities and act as a point of contact between teachers and parents, as well as the PCO and parents. All of these pieces are crucial in making our organization a supportive and vital part of ECS.



PCO Volunteer Needs

Volunteering your time with the PCO is an inexpensive way to meet the needs of our school, make an effective contribution to your child's school experience, and show your child that you value their interests. There are opportunities to fit everyone's interests and schedules. Some committees that especially need help this year are:

Staff Appreciation - Help is needed both year-round and for Staff Appreciation week (May).

Gingerbread House Event - Help plan, shop or volunteer at the event on December 2 so families can enjoy a day of creativity and merriment.

Blooming Bash - We are currently assessing whether we have adequate volunteer commitments and availability to hold this fun adults-only fundraising event next spring.

Mini Grants - Help us review mini-grant submissions four times a year and decide what to recommend for approval.

Urban Ecostewards - This group of volunteers maintains a Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy site in Frick Park and keeps it free of invasive plants. Training provided; kids and adults welcome during our after-school or weekend sessions.
