- \$611 from Box Tops

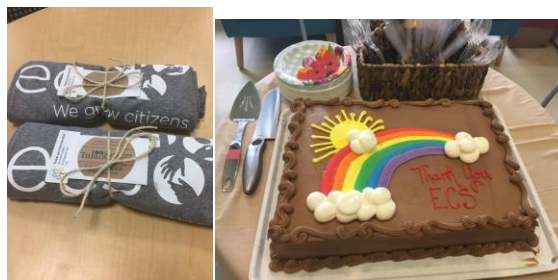
Financial Success for the year include:
